As the Easter season continues, we are beginning our first visioning process since uniting. We have chosen to participate in an all-church vision/discernment

process beginning with a workshop on April 27<sup>th</sup> at First Church of Christ in Old Saybrook, "Discerning God's Future for Your Church." We will continue this supported process for the next six months, and welcome your participation. Whether you were able to attend the first session or not, bring your faith, ideas, and concerns into the conversation!




